Around 4 a.m. Wednesday morning, *Jun 28, 2017,* 96-year-old Margarita Pitzer and her son barely escaped their Palomar Estates East manufactured home, on South Rancho Santa Fe Rd, as it went up in flames. Miraculously, homeowner Mrs. Pitzer was unharmed, while her son was treated for burns.

The members of San Marcos Mobilehome Residents Association (SMMRA) once again commends the professionalism and courage of our San Marcos Fire Department who contained the 20-foot roaring flames from spreading to neighboring homes to prevent reducing the community into cinders.
